## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Coaches:

Our Coaches are volunteers. Each coach will have the opportunity to attend a soccer rule clinic, coach clinic, and must complete the NYSCA coach course through the National Alliance for Youth Sports. Your volunteer coach should contact you within a few days after receiving their roster. There is **NO** guaranteed placement for players except for the head coach's child and siblings.

### Parents:

- At least one (1) parent **must** complete the NAYS Parent Orientation & Membership Program course.
- Parents may take the free course online at <https://www.nays.org/parents/> (Step-by-step instructions are available on our [website](#)).
- A child may **not** participate in the program until one (1) parent meets this requirement.
- We encourage you to volunteer as a coach or team parent.

### Uniforms:

- Only team jerseys are provided. Cleats, shorts, soccer socks and shin guards are the parents' responsibility.
- Team Jerseys are given to coaches for team distribution at a practice prior to games beginning.
- Shin-guards are required for all soccer league activity.
- Soccer socks are required, should be worn on the outside of the shin-guards, and long enough to pull over the shin-guard.
- There is no requirement on socks or shorts color.

### How often will my child's team meet?

- Pre-season: All teams will have one weeknight and one Saturday practice.
- Once games begin: Most teams will have one practice and one game per week; exceptions if they have a bye week.

### Where will practices and games be held?

The following is intended as a *guide* as changes may occur based on the number of teams per league, etc.:

### What are the "micro fields"?

Our U6 League sees activity at the OCMS Micro Fields which are located beside Oconee County Middle School on Mars Hill Rd. This location is listed as "OCMS Micro Fields" on Apple Maps and "OMS Micro Fields" on Google Maps.

**What are the Saturday times?**

Saturdays vary in start times ranging from 8:30 a.m. through the late afternoon to accommodate all teams.

**Will my child make a team? My player is nervous about “Try Outs”.**

Yes, all registered participants will be placed on a team.

- All U6 & U8 teams are formed to balance out the players’ ages, size and number of seasons played. This process is to ensure a better balance amongst teams.
- OCPRD holds evaluations/drafts for U10-U15 leagues where coaches rate all participants’ skills. We encourage all players and coaches to attend evaluations in order to accurately assess the skills of players. The greater number of players that attend evaluations, the more competitive and fun the season will be for everyone. These ratings are used by OCPRD staff and coaches to draft their teams.

**Does OCPRD coordinate end of season trophies?**

OCPRD does not coordinate or arrange for trophies or end of season awards.
